## Transfer Stations to Re-open - Rural Residents Only

Council has received updated advice this-morning from the Environment Protection Agency (EPA) that allows for the re-opening of all Waste Transfer Stations within the Tenterfield Shire.

From today all transfer stations will re-open <u>only</u> for "Rural residents" without kerb-side collection, to dispose of "domestic house-hold" waste.

Transfer Stations will open today, following normal schedules, specific times are available from Council's website <a href="https://www.tenterfield.nsw.gov.au/services/waste-recycling/transfer-stations">https://www.tenterfield.nsw.gov.au/services/waste-recycling/transfer-stations</a>.

Should residents present with "non-domestic house-hold waste" EPA directions are clear, and the waste will not be accepted.

All normal kerbside garbage and recycling collection services will continue as normal as well as Industrial bin collections. Please continue to place your bins out for collection before your nominated collection day.

Individuals must use their own discretion to leave their residence in light of the strict "lock down" rules currently in place.
