

COUNCILLOR BRONWYN PETRIE REAPPOINTED MAYOR FOR TENTERFIELD SHIRE

Councillor Bronwyn Petrie was re-elected as Mayor and Councillor Greg Sauer elected as Deputy Mayor at a Council Meeting held on Wednesday, 9 October 2024.

Councillor Petrie was unanimously elected to the role unopposed for a 2 year term by the ten Councillors in attendance, Crs Tim Bonner, Gregory Purcell, Roger Turner, Peter Petty, Peter Murphy, Kim Rhodes, Owen Bancroft, Greg Sauer and Peter Murphy.

The election marks Cr Petrie's second term as Mayor.

"It's an honour to represent Council and the community. I look forward to working with Deputy Mayor Greg Sauer and our fellow councillor team, with our General Manager Mr Hein Basson and the staff, and our shire community," said Cr Petrie. "Our focus will continue to be financial sustainability, accelerating our approved road infrastructure disaster repairs, efficient service delivery, and advocating for the best outcomes we can for our community".

Council also unanimously elected Cr Greg Sauer, a returning Councillor, as Deputy Mayor for a two-year term until September 2026.

Addressing the Council Chamber, Cr Sauer said, "I thank my fellow Councillors for their confidence and support in electing me to the Deputy Mayor role, and I am honoured and privileged to have been appointed. I look forward to supporting Bronwyn as Mayor, as I had for Peter Petty for 4 years".

The General Manager, Hein Basson, conveyed his congratulations to the Mayor and Deputy Mayor on behalf of all the staff at Tenterfield Shire Council, stating that the team is looking forward to working with the Mayor and Deputy Mayor over the coming term.
